INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this circular is to provide you with information regarding the proposals for the Issue Mandate, the Repurchase Mandate, the extension of the Issue Mandate and the re-election of the retiring Directors, and to seek your approval at the AGM in connection with, inter alia, such matters.

LETTER FROM THE BOARD

ISSUE MANDATE

At the annual general meeting held on 29 April 2015, the Shareholders passed an ordinary resolution to give a general mandate to the Directors to allot, issue and deal with Shares. Such general mandate will lapse at the conclusion of the AGM. It is therefore proposed to renew such general mandate at the AGM.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, the number of issued Shares is 284,057,682 Shares. Assuming that there is no change in the issued Shares between the period from the Latest Practicable Date and the date of passing the resolution approving the Issue Mandate, the maximum number of Shares which may be issued pursuant to the Issue Mandate as at the date of passing the resolution approving the Issue Mandate will be 56,811,536 Shares representing not more than 20% of the total number of issued Shares.

Ordinary resolutions will be proposed at the AGM to grant to the Directors the Issue Mandate, and authorize the extension of the Issue Mandate, details of which are set out in ordinary resolutions numbers 5 and 7 respectively in the notice of AGM.

REPURCHASE MANDATE

Also at the annual general meeting held on 29 April 2015, the Shareholders passed an ordinary resolution to give a general mandate to the Directors to exercise the powers of the Company to repurchase its own Shares. Such general mandate will lapse at the conclusion of the AGM. It is therefore proposed to renew the Repurchase Mandate at the AGM.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, the number of issued Shares is 284,057,682 Shares. Assuming that there is no change in the issued Shares between the period from the Latest Practicable Date and the date of passing the Repurchase Mandate, the maximum number of Shares which may be repurchased pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate as at the date of passing the Repurchase Mandate will be 28,405,768 Shares.

An ordinary resolution will be proposed at the AGM to grant to the Directors the Repurchase Mandate, details of which are set out in ordinary resolution number 6 in the notice of AGM. The Shares which may be repurchased pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate is limited to a maximum of 10% of total number of issued Shares as at the date of passing of the Repurchase Mandate.

An explanatory statement as required under the Listing Rules, giving certain information regarding the Repurchase Mandate, is set out in the Appendix I to this circular.

RE-ELECTION OF RETIRING DIRECTORS

The Board currently consists of seven Directors, Ms. Tsui Kam Ling, Mr. Wong Chi Ho, Mr. Wong Chi Kit, Mr. Tan Keng Boon, Ms. Kaung Cheng Xi Dawn, Mr. Lo Kar Chun, SBS, JP and Mr. Yim Kai Pung.

In accordance with article 16.18 of the Articles of Association, Ms. TSUI Kam Ling, Mr. LO Kar Chun, SBS, JP and Mr. Tan Keng Boon will retire by rotation at the AGM. Ms. TSUI Kam Ling and Mr. LO Kar Chun, SBS, JP will, being eligible, offer themselves for re-election. Mr. Tan Keng Boon, who does not offer himself for re-election due to his wish to devote more time to stay with his family, will retire at the AGM.

LETTER FROM THE BOARD

Brief biographical details of the retiring Directors proposed to be re-elected at the AGM are set out in Appendix II to this circular.

ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

The notice convening the AGM, which contains, inter alia, ordinary resolutions to approve the Issue Mandate, the Repurchase Mandate, the extension of the Issue Mandate and the re-election of the retiring Directors is set out on pages 11 to 15 of this circular.

VOTING BY WAY OF POLL

Pursuant to Rule 13.39(4) of the Listing Rules, any vote of Shareholders at a general meeting must be taken by poll except where the chairman of the meeting, in good faith, decides to allow a resolution which relates purely to a procedural or administrative matter to be voted on by a show of hands. The Company will announce the results of the poll in the manner prescribed under Rule 13.39(5) of the Listing Rules.

ACTION TO BE TAKEN

A proxy form for use at the AGM is enclosed herein. Whether or not you intend to attend the AGM, you are requested to complete the proxy form in accordance with the instructions printed thereon and return the same to the Company's branch share registrar in Hong Kong, Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited, at 17M Floor, Hopewell Centre, 183 Queen's Road East, Hong Kong as soon as possible and in any event not less than 48 hours before the time appointed for the holding of the AGM or any adjournment thereof. Completion and return of the proxy form will not preclude Shareholders from attending and voting at the AGM, or any adjourned meeting, should they so wish.

RECOMMENDATION

The Directors believe that the granting of the Issue Mandate, the Repurchase Mandate, the extension of the Issue Mandate and the re-election of the retiring Directors are in the best interests of the Company as well as to the Shareholders. This appendix serves as an explanatory statement, as required by the Listing Rules, to provide requisite information to you for your consideration.

1. EXERCISE OF THE REPURCHASE MANDATE

Exercise in full of the Repurchase Mandate, on the basis of 284,057,682 Shares in issue at the Latest Practicable Date, could result in up to 28,405,768 Shares being repurchased by the Company during the period up to (i) the conclusion of the next annual general meeting of the Company; (ii) the expiration of the period within which the next annual general meeting of the Company is required by the Articles of Association or any applicable laws to be held; or (iii) the revocation, variation or renewal of the Repurchase Mandate by ordinary resolution of the Shareholders in general meeting, whichever occurs first.

2. REASONS FOR REPURCHASES

Repurchases of Shares will only be made when the Directors believe that such a repurchase will benefit the Company and the Shareholders. Such repurchases may, depending on market conditions and funding arrangements at the time, lead to an enhancement of the net asset value of the Company and/or its earnings per Share.

3. FUNDING OF REPURCHASES

In repurchasing Shares, the Company may only apply funds legally available for such purpose in accordance with its memorandum and articles of association and the applicable laws of the Cayman Islands. The law of the Cayman Islands provides that the amount to be repaid in connection with a share repurchase may be paid from the profits of the Company and/or the proceeds of a new issue of Shares made for the purpose of the repurchase or out of capital, if the Company can, immediately following such payment, pay its debts as they fall due in the ordinary course of business. The Company may not purchase securities on the Stock Exchange for a consideration other than cash or for settlement otherwise than in accordance with the trading rules of the Stock Exchange from time to time.

4. UNDERTAKING

There might be a material adverse impact on the working capital or gearing position of the Company (as compared with the position disclosed in the audited financial statements contained in the 2015 annual report of the Company) in the event that the Repurchase Mandate is exercised in full. However, the Directors do not propose to exercise the Repurchase Mandate to such extent as would, in the circumstances, have a material adverse effect on the working capital requirements of the Company or on its gearing position which in the opinion of the Directors are from time to time appropriate for the Company.

The Directors have undertaken to the Stock Exchange that, so far as the same may be applicable, they will exercise the powers of the Company to make repurchases pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate and in accordance with the Listing Rules, the memorandum and articles of association of the Company, the laws of Hong Kong and the applicable laws of the Cayman Islands.

None of the Directors nor, to the best of their knowledge having made all reasonable enquiries, their close associates (as defined in the Listing Rules), have any present intention to sell any Shares to the Company or its subsidiaries under the Repurchase Mandate if such is approved by the Shareholders.

No core connected persons (as defined in the Listing Rules) have notified the Company that they have a present intention to sell Shares to the Company or its subsidiaries, or have undertaken not to do so, in the event that the Repurchase Mandate is approved by the Shareholders.

5. EFFECT OF TAKEOVERS CODE AND PUBLIC FLOAT

If on the exercise of the power to repurchase Shares pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate, a Shareholder's proportionate interest in the voting rights of the Company increases, such increase will be treated as an acquisition for the purposes of Rule 32 of the Takeovers Code. As a result, a Shareholder or group of Shareholders acting in concert could obtain or consolidate control of the Company and become(s) obliged to make a mandatory offer in accordance with Rules 26 and 32 of the Takeovers Code.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, Ms. Tsui Kam Ling was beneficially interested in 113,612,122 Shares, representing approximately 40.00% of the total number of issued Shares. Based on such shareholdings and in the event that the Directors exercised in full the power to repurchase Shares pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate, the shareholding of Ms. Tsui Kam Ling would be increased to approximately 44.44% of the total number of issued Shares. Accordingly, Ms. Tsui Kam Ling would be required under Rule 26 of the Takeovers Code to make a mandatory offer in respect of all the issued Shares by reason of such increase. However, the Directors will not repurchase Shares to such an extent as would result in takeover obligations. Save as aforesaid, the Directors are not aware of any consequence which may arise under the Takeovers Code as a consequence of any repurchases made under the Repurchase Mandate.

The Directors will use their best endeavours to ensure that the Repurchase Mandate will not be exercised to the extent that the number of Shares held by the public being reduced to less than 25% as required under the Listing Rules.

6. SHARE PURCHASED MADE BY THE COMPANY

The Company has not repurchased any Shares (whether on the Stock Exchange or otherwise) in the six months preceding the Latest Practicable Date.

Ms. Tsui Kam Ling

Ms. Tsui Kam Ling, aged 63, is an executive Director, the Chairman of the Board and the Chairman of the Nomination Committee. She joined the Group in September 1998 and was mainly responsible for supervising the sourcing of raw materials, logistics, human resources and finance. She was appointed as an executive Director on 23 March 2005, a member of the Nomination Committee on 30 March 2012 and the Chairman of the Board on 24 March 2015. She is also the director of several subsidiaries of the Group. Ms. Tsui graduated from The Chinese University of Hong Kong with a Bachelor of Arts degree in October 1975. She is the mother of Mr. Wong Chi Ho and Mr. Wong Chi Kit, both are executive Directors. She is also a substantial Shareholder of the Company. She has not held any directorships in any listed public companies in the last three years. Save as disclosed above, she does not hold any positions with the Company or other members of the Company's group.

Save as disclosed above, Ms. Tsui does not have any other relationships with any Directors, senior management, management Shareholders, substantial Shareholders, or controlling Shareholders.

Ms. Tsui has entered into a service agreement with the Company for a term of two years until 26 October 2016, subject to her retirement and re-election at the annual general meeting of the Company in accordance with the articles of association of the Company. Under the agreement, either party may terminate the agreement at any time by giving to the other not less than three months' prior written notice. Her monthly salary is determined with reference to market rate. Ms. Tsui is entitled to a discretionary management bonus from the Company. The remuneration, including salary, discretionary bonus and retirement scheme contribution, payable to Ms. Tsui during the year ended 31 December 2015 amounted to approximately HK\$1,098,000.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, Ms. Tsui is interested in 113,612,122 Shares within the meaning of Part XV of the SFO which represents approximately 40.00% of the total number of issued Shares. Save as disclosed above, Ms. Tsui does not have any other interests in Shares within the meaning of Part XV of the SFO.

Save as disclosed above, Ms. Tsui has confirmed that there is no other information required to be brought to the attention of the Shareholders and the Company or to be disclosed pursuant to Rule 13.51(2) of the Listing Rules in relation to her re-election as Director.

Mr. Lo Kar Chun, SBS, JP

Mr. Lo Kar Chun, aged 64, was appointed as an independent non-executive Director on 17 March 2014. He is also a member of the Audit Committee and the Nomination Committee, and the Chairman of the Remuneration Committee. Mr. Lo Kar Chun started his career as an Administrative Officer in the Hong Kong Government in 1974, occupying various senior positions in the Hong Kong Government during his 13 years of public service, before joining the private

sector in 1987. He was the President and Chief Executive Officer in Synnex Technology International (HK) Ltd from December 1987 to December 2013 and Synnex Distributions (China) Ltd since its inception until December 2013. Mr. Lo is currently the Chairman of the Independent Commission on Remuneration for Members of the Executive Council and the Legislature, and Officials under the Political Appointment System of the Hong Kong Special Administration Region. He is also a member of the Exchange Fund Advisory Committee in Hong Kong. Mr. Lo obtained a Bachelor of Science General (First Class Honour) degree from The University of Hong Kong in November 1973. He has not held any directorships in any listed public companies in the last three years. Save as disclosed above, he does not hold any positions with the Company or other members of the Company's group.

Mr. Lo does not have any other relationships with any Directors, senior management, management Shareholders, substantial Shareholders, or controlling Shareholders.
